A CD recording of music by Handel and his contemporaries

played by Robert Woolley on the 1766 Thomas Parker organ at Leatherhead Parish Church, will be on sale during the Flower Festival. All proceeds will go to Church funds. Thomas Parker was Handel's favourite organ builder. The Parker organ at Leatherhead was hidden for many years inside a later Victorian organ, and was only recently rediscovered and restored back to its original condition, exactly as built, with the aid of the Lottery Heritage Fund.
