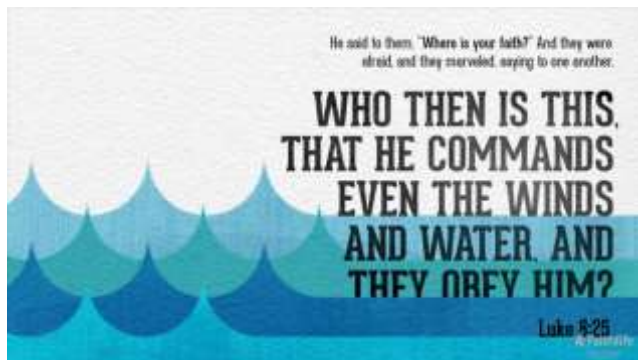
Morning prayer will take place Tuesday to Friday at 9am. Please join us.

Every 6 years the Electoral Roll of a parish must be completely reviewed. This was last done in 2019 so we are renewing our Electoral Roll in 2025. Everyone who wishes to have their

name entered on the new Roll must complete an application form (even if they are on the current roll). The form must be returned to Sue Prentice or the Parish Office by 26<sup>th</sup> March.

The new Roll will be published on 29<sup>th</sup> March which is more than 14 days before the APCM on 13<sup>th</sup> April. Anyone wishing to vote at the APCM must be on the new Electoral Roll.

Forms will be email or sent to all Parishioners on the current Electoral Roll. They can also be found in Church or from the Parish Office.
