Holy Communion will take place at 10am every Wednesday.

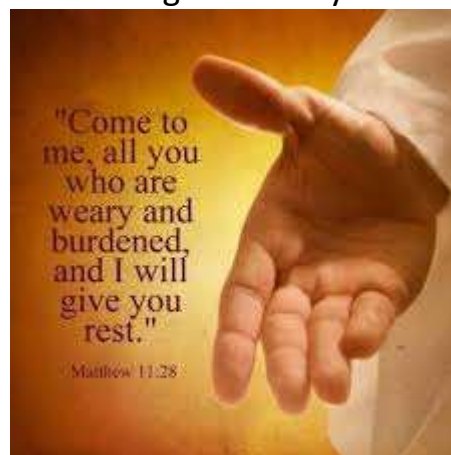
