Thursday Mattins will take place each week at 10am.

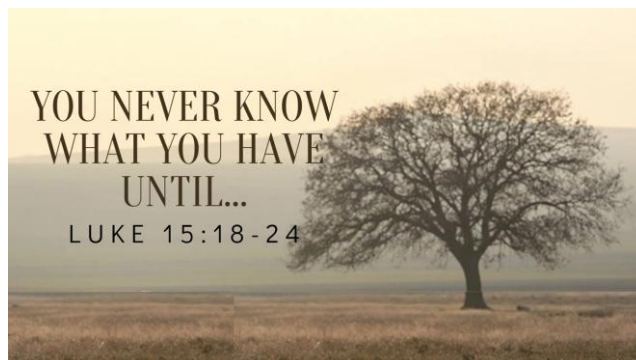

## REQUEST

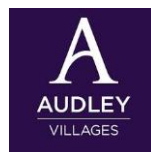
