Morning prayer will take place on Mondays and Tuesdays at 9am .

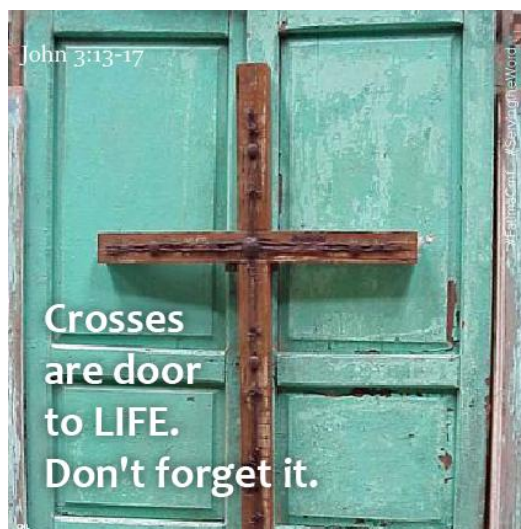
Holy Communion will take place at 10am every Wednesday.
