## Easter Week Services explained

### Compline: (Mon, Tues & Wed 8pm)

A quiet night prayer service that reflects on Jesus' suffering and prepares believers spiritually for Good Friday.

**Maundy Thursday at 8pm (washing of feet & stripping of the altar):** Commemorates Jesus Christ washing his disciples' feet as a sign of humble service and symbolically strips the altar to represent his abandonment and the coming crucifixion.

### Stations of the Cross: Good Friday 2-3pm

A devotional walk-through key moment of The Passion of Christ, remembering Jesus' journey to the crucifixion.

### Tenebrae: Good Friday at 8pm

A solemn service where candles are gradually extinguished to symbolize the growing darkness surrounding Jesus' death.

### Dawn Service: Easter Sunday at 5.30am (with hot cross buns, tea and coffee afterwards)

An early morning gathering on Easter Sunday celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ and the hope of new life.
