Holy Communion will take place at 10am every Wednesday.

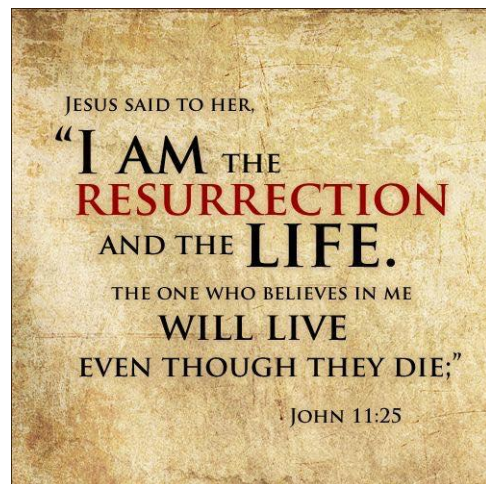
Christian Meditation will take place at 5pm on Wednesday
