The Church is open for Morning prayer at 9am each weekday Monday to Thursday and will remain open until Evening prayer at 5pm - Rev Phe will attend these when available

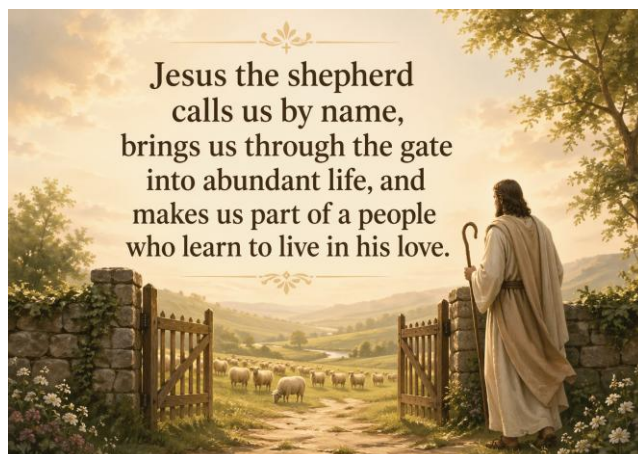
